Our activities this week will help us remember Jesus's sacrifice for us!


Tuesday, May 5, 2020

- **Concentration.** Play a game of *Concentration* with a partner. Use the cards at the end of this page. Start by turning over two cards. If a match, you get to keep those cards and go again. If not a match, your partner gets a turn. Continue playing until all the matches are found.

Wednesday, May 6, 2020

- **Communion Craft.** Decorate the communion cup. Color the cross in the circle. Then, take a piece of yarn and tape one end to the back of the circle and tape the other end of the yarn to

the back of the cup. After you finish decorating your cup, read the story from **Luke 22:14-20**.



Thursday, May 7, 2020

- **Service.** Place an empty cup and plate on your table at dinner. As a family, think about the people who do not have food or drink. In what ways can you help people who are hungry or thirsty during this time? Can you find a way to support them through a local care agency?

Friday, May 8, 2020

- **Tradition.** Sharing the Passover Meal was a tradition the Jewish people shared, but the Passover meal Jesus shared with the disciples was different because he changed the tradition by saying the bread was His body and the wine was His blood (Matthew 26: 26-29). Over dinner, share some of your favorite family traditions. Write 3 of them in the box below.



