Fill in the Blank. Read Luke 24: 30-31 to fill in the blanks to this passage: .

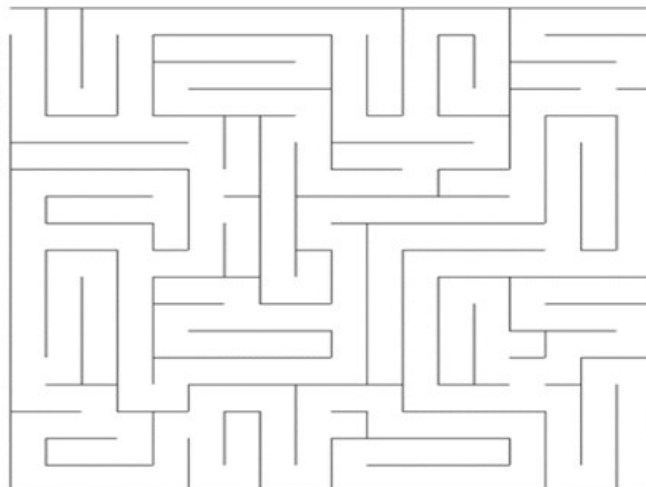
