**Monday, April 13, 2020**

**TOMB PAINTING.** Peter & John race to the tomb where Jesus was buried because they heard it was empty. Read John 20: 1-12. Who else is at the empty tomb? Use your art supplies create a picture of the scene described. What details do you think are important to include?

**Tuesday, April 14, 2020**

**Solve the Cryptogram.** Read John 20: 18 to help you solve the cryptogram.

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**Wednesday, April 15, 2020**

**Make it Disappear.** It looked like Jesus had disappeared from the tomb, but he was really there (verse 17). Today, let's learn an illusion that makes it look like something disappears, but it is still there. **Thursday, April 16, 2020**

**Act It Out.** Share the Bible story today with by either acting it out (you may have to enlist the help of other in your family) or by building the setting with LEGOS/blocks and using your other toys as the people. For added fun, ask an adult to video tape your performance.

**Friday, April 17, 2020**

**Dance Party.** Let's celebrate that Jesus is ALIVE!!! Choose your favorite praise song, turn up the volume, and have a dance party!
