United Methodist Women Mission Projects

We commit to mission work in our community and beyond. Some of the mission projects supported by Church of the Saviour UMW are:

Cooper's Trace Nursing & Rehabilitation— Easter baskets are provided for all residents coordinated by Susanna Wesley Women in Mission since 2005. Also, cards with a small cash gift are given at Christmas time since 2015.

Blue Ash Backpack Bundles—Non-perishable food is collected year-round for underprivileged students at Blue Ash Elementary School since 2014.

Foster Care to Success—Since 2006, Lydia Needlecrafter have sent scarves to college aged young adults who were in foster care.

Gifts from the Heart—Tuesday Morning Hannah sponsors this church-wide project to make Christmas brighter for children and their families in our local communities by providing gifts to those in need since 1994.

Prayer Shawls are made by Lydia Needlecrafters and given to members and friends in need of healing since 2004.

Project 5000—UMW coordinates this churchwide program providing food to several local food pantries since 2001.

Wesley Chapel Mission Center—This Over-the-Rhine after school program for K-12 receives contributions of school supplies, snacks and hands-on help from UMW members and the Children's Closet since 2003.

Wesley Education Center in Avondale is a child care center that serves children ages 6 weeks to age 13. The center receives contributions of diapers, wipes, and clothing from our UMW members, Montgomery Nursery School families and the Children's Closet since 1990.

Childcare is available by request for all UMW events.


