Psalm 84

As you begin to read this psalm, you can hear the desire or longing to meet God. What do you think the Psalmist likes about God's dwelling place? Read verse 2 and think of two things that you have before longed and yearned for. How does the Psalmist describe their own hearts' desire? Do you sense a personal drawing to God? When was your last encounter with God? What was your experience? We are all longing to be back in a sanctuary for worship, however we know we can meet God anywhere, at any time. Take time this week to sit with God, what do you hear? Feel?

Tuesday, 07.14.20

Ephesians 2:19-22

The words directed to the Ephesians also have a meaning for us. We speak of the church being God's house. God's household is not a building but a group of people. God lives in us and gives us daily opportunities to have an encounter with God's holiness. What reassurance and strength do you receive from this?

Wednesday, 07.15.20

1 Corinthians 3:10-17

Paul's words challenge our method of discipleship. Do we attach others to ourselves as the foundation, or to Christ? Do we use our abilities and spiritual gifts to build up others in the church or keep them tied to us? What is the temple? How does the truth that, in Christ, we are the temple of God draw us together as the church?

Thursday, 07.16.20

Ephesians 3:16-19

Define God's love. In what ways does having a bad experience with receiving love from either family or friends affect how you interpret God's love? Do you believe it is possible to fully understand the love of God? Why or why not? How do you think something as mysterious as

the love of God can change anyone who experiences it? Paul wrote that every believer needs to be rooted and established in love. How does a believer in Christ know if they are truly rooted and established in love? Paul wants all believers to know the full dimension of God's love. What has the love of God compelled you to do?

Friday, 07.17.20

Psalm 122

Psalm 122 speaks about being on a journey with God. Is there a key faith event or person that propelled you along your journey with god? We long for peace with God, in our homes and in our world. Where is peace needed most in your life right now? World? What does it look like to have peace with your family?

Saturday, 07.18.20
